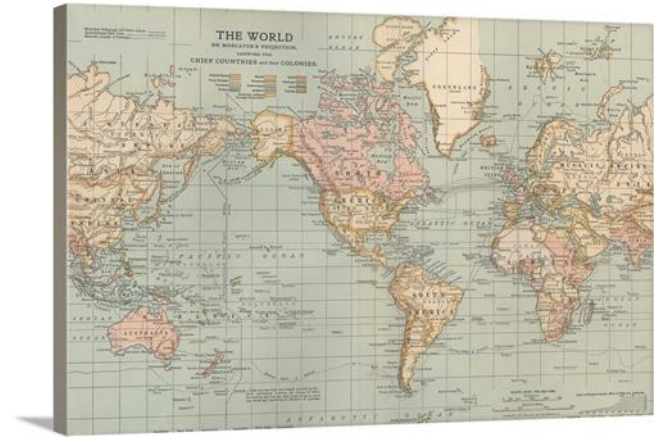

ECI ALWAYS APPLIES ACADEMIC APPROACH TO THE CLASSES

ECI Curriculum and methodology evolve and shape according to the needs of the students. We started the Semester 2024 with one Beginning level 2 (ESL102) One Intermediate Level (ESL 203- Intermediate 3) and Advanced Level (ESL301). The classes are tailored to meet the academic needs of the student: emphasis has been made on research paper writing, Composition I and II, as well as paraphrasing and summary for the advanced levels and high Intermediate levels and Essay Writing including Sentence structure and Language use for the Beginning levels. The Grammar classes go beyond foundational grammar and extend into the comprehensive analysis of clauses (adjective, adverbial, noun) as well as giving analytical approach of the relationship of the components of the sentence (syntax). Students also have been reading college advanced texts with comprehensive academic vocabulary. The beginning level Reading and Comprehension also includes interpretation vocabulary from the context.
